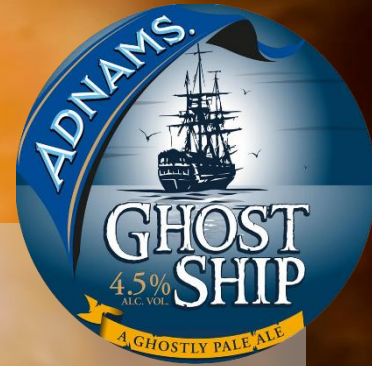

1. Ghost Ship



Brauerei: Adnams Brewery

Art: Pale Ale

Alkohol: 4,5%

Beschreibung: A pale ale with an assertive pithy bitterness, biscuit flavours and fresh citrus aromas

Durchschnittsbewertung: 6,9/10

2. Hobgoblin



Brauerei: Wychwood Brewery

Art: Bitter Ale / Ruby Beer

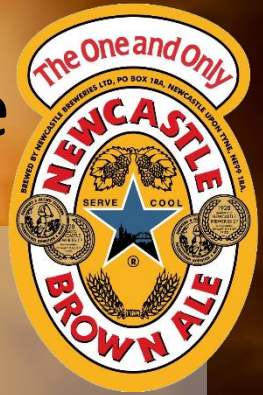
Alkohol: 5,2%

Beschreibung: Strong in roasted malt with a moderate hoppy bitterness and slight fruity character that lasts through to the end.

Durchschnittsbewertung: 5,7/10



3. Newcastle Brown Ale



Brauerei: Newcastle / Heineken

Art: Brown Ale

Alkohol: 4,7%

Beschreibung: Brewed with a unique blend of a pale malt and darker caramel malt to give its smooth, characteristic flavour and colour

Disclaimer: In 2015, it was announced that caramel colouring, which has been used since the beer was launched would be removed from the beer for health reasons. Instead, roasted malt would be used to darken the beer. In 2017, Heineken announced that Newcastle production will move from the John Smith's Brewery in the U.K. to the Zoeterwoude Brewery in Holland.

4. Scottish Ale



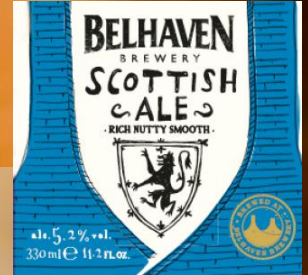
Brauerei: Belhaven / Greene King

Art: Scottish Ale

Alkohol: 5,2%

Beschreibung: Malty and hoppy, delivering a sweet, smooth and creamy finish

Durchschnittsbewertung: 4,7/10



5. India Pale Ale



Brauerei: Shepherd's Neame

Art: India Pale Ale

Alkohol: 6,1%

Beschreibung: Delivers potent bitterness, offset with generous amounts of pale ale malt to deliver a balanced, yet uncompromising brew.

Durchschnittsbewertung: 5,8/10



6. Rum Finish



Brauerei: Innis & Gunn

Art: Matured Ale / Strong Ale

Alkohol: 6,8%

Beschreibung: Matured over oak heartwood infused with specially selected rums, its spicy, full-bodied qualities make it a lively choice.

Durchschnittsbewertung: 5,5/10



7. Nut Brown Ale



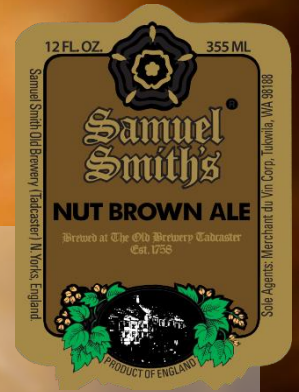
Brauerei: Samuel Smith

Art: Brown Ale

Alkohol: 5%

Beschreibung: Relatively dry with a rich amber-brown colour and nutty flavour derived exclusively from small amounts of dark malt.

Durchschnittsbewertung: 5,9/10



8. Cocoa Wonderland



Brauerei: Thornbridge Brewery

Art: Porter

Alkohol: 6,8%

Beschreibung: Full bodied, robust porter with natural mocha malt flavours, complementing the decadent additions of real cocoa beans to the maturation process

Durchschnittsbewertung: 7,1/10
