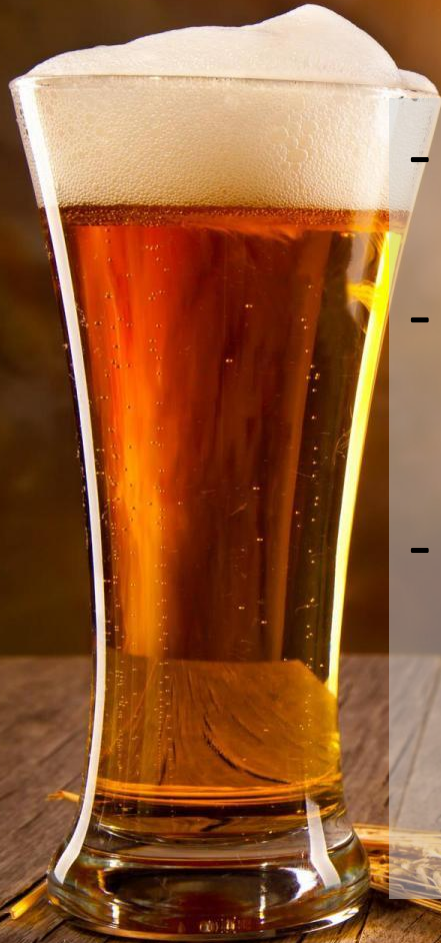

# 1. Mongozo Coconut

Brauerei: Brouwerij Huyghe, Belgien

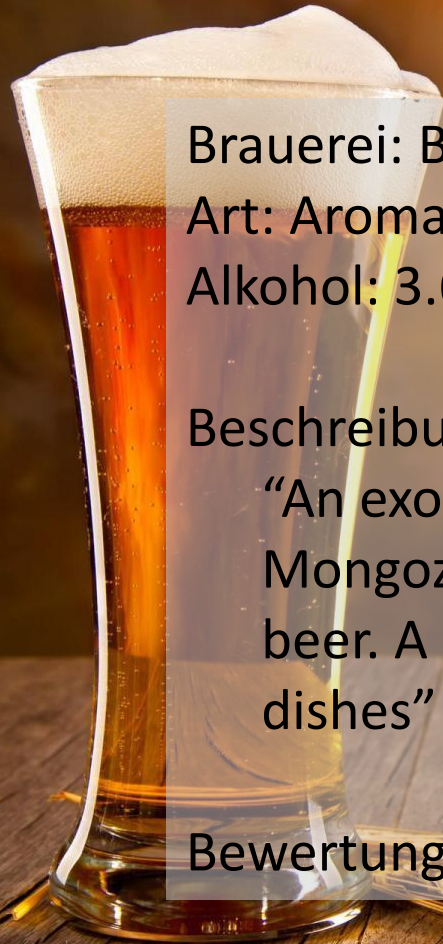
Art: Aromatisiertes Witbier

Alkohol: 3.6 %

Beschreibung:

“An exotic beer with the refreshing taste of coconut. Mongozo Buckwheat White forms the basis for this beer. A beer that is perfect for pairing with exotic dishes”

Bewertung: 5.9/10



## 2. Prenzlauer Null

Brauerei: Põhjala, Estland

Art: Alkoholfreies Berliner Weisse mit Himbeeren

Alkohol: 0.5 %

Beschreibung:

“Smooth, fresh oats mix with sweet lactose to give creamy body balanced by a fresh raspberry taste. Gentle acidity comes through on the aftertaste with more raspberries following”

Bewertung: 5.3/10



## 3. Sleepy Fox

Brauerei: Monyo, Ungarn

Art: Traubenbier

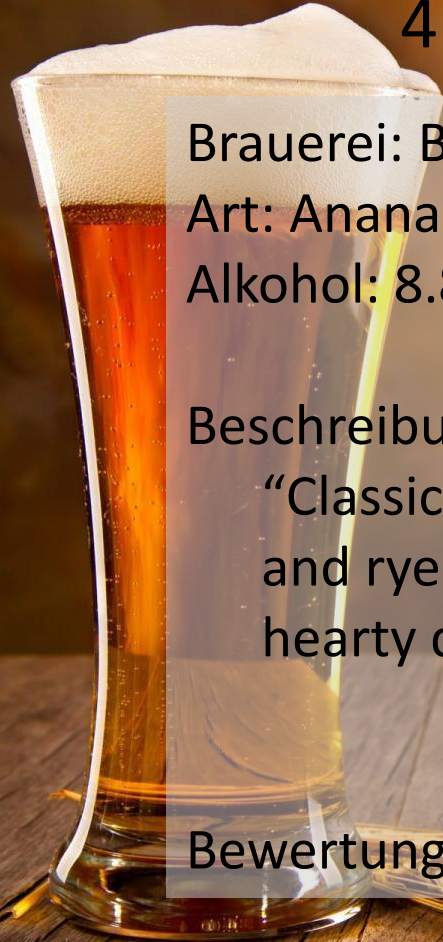
Alkohol: 5.8 %

Beschreibung:

“A real autumnal beer. Sleepy Fox is a blue grape ale made even more exciting with Zweigelt grape juice and Cascara (coffee fruit) from the Bányai estate in Costa Rica. It's light, fresh and tart, best recommended for those overcast autumn evenings.”

## 4. Double the Gun, Double the Fun



Brauerei: Bier-Freunde Seeland, Schweiz  
Art: Ananas Double New England India Pale Ale  
Alkohol: 8.8 %

Beschreibung:

“Classic, hoppy NEIPA brewed with barley, wheat, oat and rye , a combination of New Zealand hops and a hearty dose of pineapple juice”

Bewertung: 6.3/10





## 5. Snorkelers IPA

Brauerei: Rügener Inselbrauerei, Deutschland

Art: Salziges, alkoholfreies IPA

Alkohol: 0.5 %

Beschreibung:

“The Snorkeler's Sea Salt IPA lets you dive into a variety of flavors. It sparkles amber in the glass and smells delightfully citrusy. The palate is surprised by a slightly mineral note and yet it shows its stylish hop power, paired with a finely integrated pinch of salt. Typically Baltic refreshing!”

Bewertung: 4.3/10

## 6. Kafirweisse

Brauerei: Tyrell Braukunstatelier, Deutschland

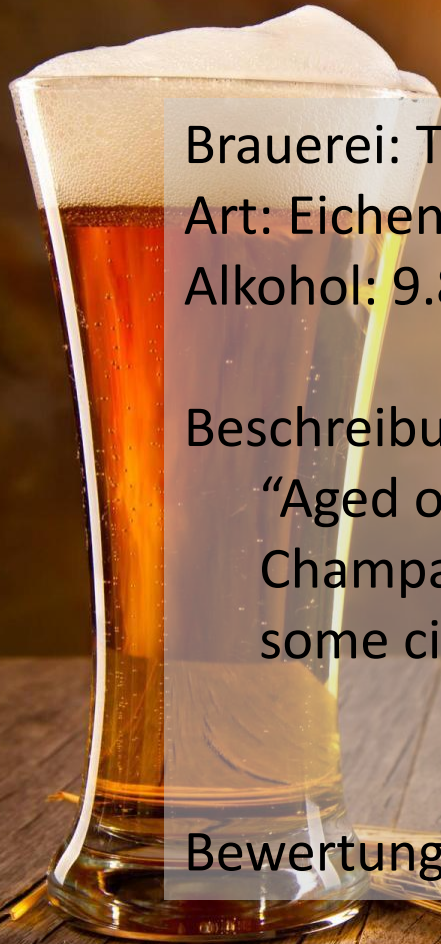
Art: Eichenfassgelagertes Triple-Weissbier

Alkohol: 9.8 %

Beschreibung:

“Aged on Kafir lime leaves and ginger root, this Champagne of the North has a decent tartness and some citrusy vibes.”

Bewertung: 5.1/10







## 7. Nostra Biera Cicculata

Brauerei: Brasserie Pietra, Korsika

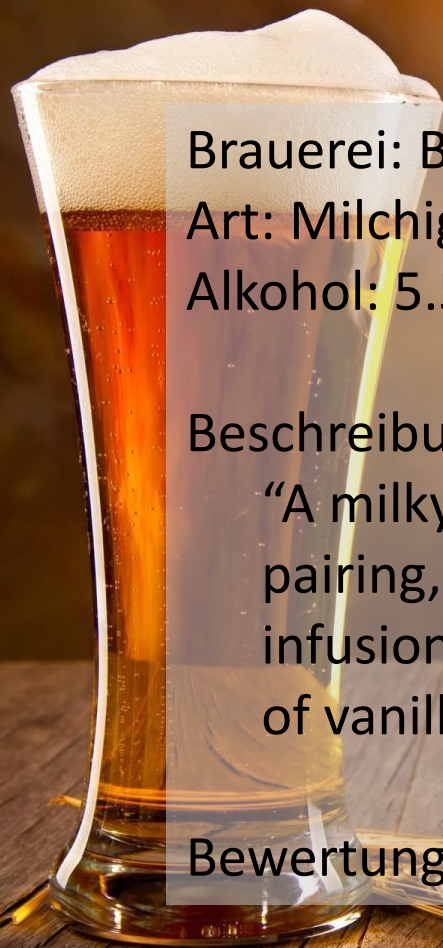
Art: Milchiges Schokoladenbier

Alkohol: 5.5 %

Beschreibung:

“A milky chocolate ale, a generous chocolate-alcohol pairing, a brew of pale malt and chocolate malt. A cold infusion of roasted cocoa bean nibs softened by a hint of vanilla.”

Bewertung: 6.1/10



## 8. Feuillette

Brauerei: Brasserie de la Jonte, Frankreich

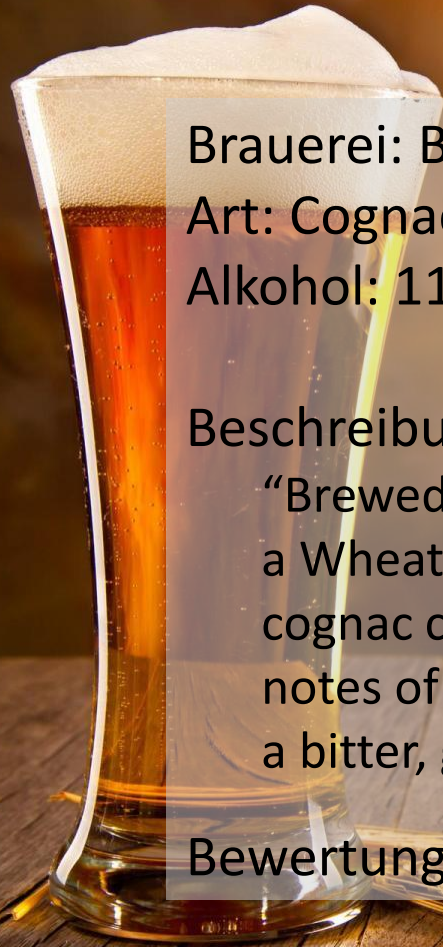
Art: Cognac-Fass-gereiftes Himbeer Wheat Triple IPA

Alkohol: 11.0 %

Beschreibung:

“Brewed on a malted base of barley and wheat, Feuillette is a Wheat IPA pimped with raspberry before being aged in cognac casks. On the palate, Feuillette opens with generous notes of raspberry, followed by the sweetness of cognac and a bitter, grapefruit finish from Summit hops.”

Bewertung: 6.2/10







## 9. Abbaye Saint Bon-Chien

Brauerei: Brasserie Franche Montagne, Schweiz

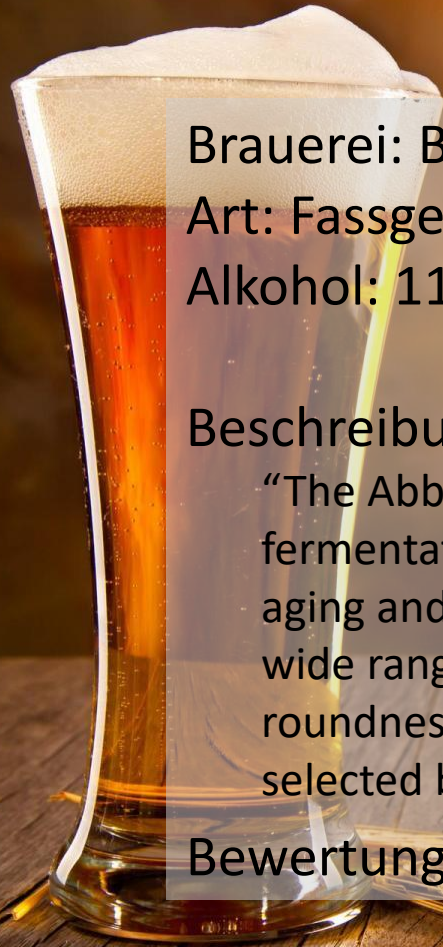
Art: Fassgereiftes Sauerbier

Alkohol: 11.0 %

Beschreibung:

“The Abbaye de Saint Bon-Chien is a strong sour ale of mixed fermentation, aged during a year in old wine oak barrels. The oak aging and the action of wild yeasts confer this beer’s astonishing wide range of aromas. Its outstanding complexity, balance, roundness and long finish, are the fruit of the meticulous blend of selected barrels.”

Bewertung: 5.7/10





## 10. Moctezuma

Brauerei: Seven Island Brewery, Griechenland

Art: Haselnuss Imperial Stout

Alkohol: 13.0 %

Beschreibung:

“Incredible powerful roasted hazelnut flavors from naturally roasted nuts.”

Bewertung: 6.3/10
